ORDER

**DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED**

On March 13, 2012, 1 800 Collect, Inc. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 12-095.

In a letter dated May 16, 2017, Lance J.M. Steinhart, Attorney for 1 800 Collect, Inc., requested the Commission cancel the company's certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as it is no longer providing service to customers in Oregon. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2017, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by 1 800 Collect, Inc. should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by 1 800 Collect, Inc. is canceled.
