DISPOSITION: **RATE SCHEDULES SUSPENDED FOR ADDITIONAL
PERIOD OF TIME**

At its April 18, 2017 Regular Public Meeting, the Commission ordered suspension of Advice No. 17-05, filed by Portland General Electric Company, for a period of six months from May 1, 2017, pending an investigation.¹

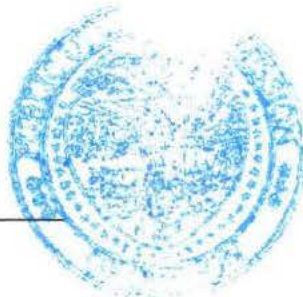
The Commission will not have an opportunity to complete its investigation in this case prior to the expiration of the initial suspension period. Accordingly, the suspension should be extended for an additional period not exceeding three months as provided by ORS 757.215(1).

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Advice No. 17-05, filed by Portland General Electric Company, is suspended for an additional period of not more than three months beyond the last day of the initial suspension period set forth in Order No. 17-153.
