DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORITY CANCELED

On March 4, 1987, Integra Telecom Of Oregon, Inc. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Docket UM 96, Order No. 87-270. Integra Telecom Of Oregon, Inc. was granted additional authority on September 23, 1996, in Docket CP 136, Order No. 96-248; and on October 1, 1997, in Docket CP 348, Order No. 97-385.

In a letter dated March 23, 2018, Douglas Denney of Allstream requested the Commission cancel the company's certificates of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as it was part of an internal consolidation into Electric Lightwave, LLC dba Allstream. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2018, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificates of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Integra Telecom Of Oregon, Inc. should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificates of authority held by Integra Telecom Of Oregon, Inc. are canceled.
