ORDER

DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORITY CANCELED

On September 23, 1996, Shared Communications, Inc. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Docket CP 163, Order No. 96-248. Shared Communications, Inc. was granted additional authority on December 30, 1996, in Dockets CP 132 and CP 149, Order No. 96-340; and on November 3, 1997, in Docket CP 351, Order No. 97-423.

In a letter dated March 23, 2018, Douglas Denney of Allstream requested the Commission cancel the company's certificates of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as it was part of an internal consolidation into Electric Lightwave, LLC dba Allstream. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2018, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificates of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Shared Communications, Inc. should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificates of authority held by Shared Communications, Inc. are canceled.
