ORDER

**DISPOSITION: DOCKET CLOSED**

On April 23, 2018, Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition, Renewable Energy Coalition, and Community Renewable Energy Association (complainants) filed a complaint against Portland General Electric Company. On May 10, 2018, complainants filed a notice of dismissal stating that they withdraw their complaint.

ORCP 54A, as applied to Commission proceedings through OAR 860-001-0000(1), allows a complainant to dismiss an action in its entirety without an order of the Commission. Accordingly, the Commission considers this matter to be resolved, and this docket should be closed.

**ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that the complaint filed by Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition, Renewable Energy Coalition, and Community Renewable Energy Association against Portland General Electric Company is considered resolved, and docket UM 1940 is closed.
