ORDER

DISPOSITION: \$208.00 CHARGES ASSESSED

In this order, the Public Utility Commission assesses \$208.00 against FLEX NETWORKS LLC for failure to make required payments. The Commission designates its files on the subject of this matter as the record in this case and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

FLEX NETWORKS LLC is a telecommunications provider required to submit an annual gross revenue fee statement and fee payment to the Commission.¹ These amounts can include the outstanding annual fee; a late statement fee,² and late payment penalty.³

FLEX NETWORKS LLC failed to submit the statement and payment by the due date of April 2, 2018.⁴

The Commission sent a Proposed Order to FLEX NETWORKS LLC on June 1, 2018. FLEX NETWORKS LLC did not respond with full payment, and all current amounts owing have not been paid.

CONCLUSIONS

FLEX NETWORKS LLC failed to provide an annual gross revenue statement and fee payment required by law. FLEX NETWORKS LLC owes the current balance of \$208.00.

The amount set forth above should be assessed with the applicable late payment penalty to accrue at accrue at 2 percent per month on the balance of the annual fee due until the Commission receives full payment. Failure to comply with the terms of this order may result in the Commission suspending or cancelling the telecommunications provider's Certificate of Authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon.⁵

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. FLEX NETWORKS LLC is assessed \$208.00 immediately due and payable to the Public Utility Commission, PO Box 2153, Salem, Oregon 97308-2153.
- 2. Where applicable, the late payment penalty will continue to accrue at 2 percent per month until the Commission receives full payment.
