ORDER

DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED

On July 14, 1992, Operator Service Co. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 92-1012.

In a letter received April 26, 2019, Shae Calhoun, Tax Agent for Operator Service Co., requested the Commission cancel the company's certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as it has closed its business and is no longer providing service in Oregon. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2019, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Operator Service Co. should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Operator Service Co. is canceled.
