Advice No. 19-05 (ADV 929), Schedule 150, Transportation Electrification Cost Recovery Mechanism.

DISPOSITION: ADVICE WITHDRAWAL ACKNOWLEDGED; DOCKET CLOSED

On April 23, 2019, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed Advice No. 19-05 (ADV 929), Schedule 150, Transportation Electrification Cost Recovery Mechanism to recover costs associated with transportation electrification pilot projects. On April 26, 2019, in Order No. 19-157, the Commission adopted the recommendation of the Staff of the Oregon Public Utility Commission (Staff) to suspend and investigate PGE's proposed tariff for a period not to exceed six months.

The Oregon Citizens' Utility Board and the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers subsequently became parties to these proceedings and, in conjunction with Staff, engaged in settlement discussions with PGE.

On August 29, 2019, PGE formally withdrew Schedule 150, Advice 19-05, based upon a revised stipulation reached in Docket No. UM 1811 in which it agreed not to seek cost recovery for capital related costs associated with the three pilot projects subject to this proceeding.<sup>1</sup>
