On August 1, 2016, CallCatchers, Inc. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 16-287.

Marashlian, Counsel for CallCatchers, Inc., requested the Commission cancel the company's certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as it is no longer needed due to an operational reorganization. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2019, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.
