DISPOSITION: TIME LINE SPECIFIED IN ORDER NO. 19-087 AMENDED

On March 14, 2019, the Commission issued Order No. 19-087, changing certain elements in a previous decision adopting a stipulation for Pacific Power's transportation electrification pilot programs. This same order also changed certain dates in a previously approved stipulation, including Paragraph 21 of the original stipulation, which was modified to read as follows:

PacifiCorp will provide progress updates on all transportation electrification pilot programs and pilots to the Commission by March 31, 2019, and March 31, 2020.

The Chief Administrative Law Judge has been delegated the authority to modify time lines specified in a Commission order.¹ Exercising that authority, I find good cause to amend Order 19-087 to change the progress update deadline for 2020 from March 31, 2020, to May 29, 2020.

ORDER

PacifiCorp will provide progress updates on all transportation electrification pilot programs and pilots to the Commission by March 31, 2019, and May 29, 2020.

The remainder of the order is unchanged.
