ORDER

DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED

On May 15, 2003, Communications Access Cooperative Holding Enterprise was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 03-307.

In a letter received August 10, 2020, Libby Calnon, General Manager of Hood River Electric Cooperative, requested the Commission cancel the company's certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as it merged with Hood River Electric Cooperative as of January 1, 2020. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2020, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Communications Access Cooperative Holding Enterprise should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Communications Access Cooperative Holding Enterprise is canceled.
