STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Approve recommended project for pre-certification in the Community Solar Program.

DISCUSSION:

<u>Issue</u>

Whether the Oregon Public Utility Commission (OPUC or Commission) should approve the recommended Community Solar project for pre-certification.

Applicable Rule or Law

Section 22 of Senate Bill 1547, effective March 8, 2016, and codified in ORS 757.386, directs the Commission to establish a community solar program (hereinafter referred to as "Program", or "CSP").

On June 29, 2017, the Commission adopted formal rules for the Program under OAR Division 88 of Chapter 860. OAR 860-088-0040 details the requirements for project pre-certification.

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Analysis

Background

Project Managers registered with the CSP may submit applications for project precertification to the CSP platform. As required by OAR 860-088-0040(3), the CSP Program Administrator reviews the applications for compliance with Program requirements and recommends whether the Commission approve the projects for precertification.

The Program Administrator recently received a pre-certification application for the following project. After reviewing the application and supporting documentation provided by the Project Manager, the Program Administrator has determined that this project qualifies for pre-certification in the CSP and recommends approval.

This project will be installed on the Oregon Shakespeare Festival production facility in Talent, which survived the wildfire that destroyed much of Talent in September. The project was initiated by Solarize Rogue, a community-based non-profit in Southern Oregon, and will be owned jointly by approximately 16 local households that will provide the initial capital investment and fund the ongoing maintenance. The Project Manager is Oregon Clean Power Cooperative, which has successfully installed cooperatively-owned solar projects around Oregon. The project will utilize capacity in the Program's small capacity carve-out, in which 25 percent of the Program's initial interim capacity allocation is reserved for projects smaller than 360 kW-AC or managed by a non-profit or public entity as project manager.

Conclusion

Staff has discussed this project application with the Program Administrator and reviewed the CSP requirements. Staff supports the Program Administrator's recommendation that the Commission approve the recommended project for precertification in the CSP.
