ORDER

DISPOSITION: COMPLAINT DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE; DOCKET CLOSED

On December 23, 2020, Willamette Falls Paper Company (WFalls) and West Linn Paper Company (WLP) and Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed a joint motion to dismiss with prejudice all claims raised in these proceedings.

In these proceedings, WFalls and WLP sought to confirm eligibility for long-term direct access service, and requested a waiver for the Commission's rules regarding new load direct access. The joint motion states that the parties have agreed to a settlement which resolves all issues in this case.

The settlement of disputes by mutual agreement is an efficient means of furthering the public interest. WFalls and WLP's complaint is dismissed with prejudice with respect to all claims.

This order is limited to approval of the request by the parties to dismiss this case with prejudice. The terms of the settlement entered into by the parties have not been put before the Commission, and the Commission has not reviewed or issued a decision regarding these terms.
