ORDER

DISPOSITION: TIME LINE SPECIFIED IN ORDER NO. 20-108 AMENDED

On June 30, 2021, Aspen Lakes Utility Company (Aspen Lakes) submitted a motion for a 60-day extension to file its General Rate Revision. The stipulation, signed by Aspen Lakes, Staff, Aspen Lakes Golf Course and Aspen Lakes Estate Owners, Incorporated, and adopted by the Commission in Order No. 20-108, requires the filing of a general rate case on or before June 30, 2021.

Order No. 20-108 incorporated the stipulation the motion seeks to amend. Accordingly, to effectively change the deadline for the filing of the general rate case, the order itself must be amended. No party filed a response to the motion. Aspen Lakes states that it is “diligently working on its filing but has limited staff resources and requires an additional 60 days to complete its filing.”

The Chief Administrative Law Judge has been delegated the authority to modify time lines specified in a Commission order.¹ Exercising that authority, I find good cause to amend Order No. 20-108. Ordering paragraph number 4, which requires Aspen Lakes to file a request for a general rate revision “no later than June 30, 2021” is amended to state the revised requirement of “no later than August 30, 2021.”
