ORDER

DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED

On September 4, 2009, TeleSpan Communications, LLC was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 09-346.

In a letter received August 19, 2021, Karen Poythress, Manager/Member for TeleSpan Communications, LLC, requested the Commission cancel the company's certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as it is not providing service in Oregon. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2021, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by TeleSpan Communications, LLC should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by TeleSpan Communications, LLC is canceled.
