Determination of Late-Payment Rate and Interest Accrued on Customer Deposits.

DISPOSITION: CORRECTED DATE IN ORDER NO. 21-414

On November 17, 2021, the Commission issued Order No. 21-414, which adopted the Staff recommendation for the determination of late payment rates and interest accrued customer deposits.

The order states within the conclusion of Appendix A under the heading Proposed Commission Motion on page 8:

Staff recommends the Commission:

2. Approve an annual interest rate of 0.1 percent on customer deposits for calendar year 2021.

This section of the order references calendar year 2021, however, the year which it should have reflected was 2022.

The Chief Administrative Law Judge has been delegated the authority to modify dates specified in a Commission order. Exercising that authority, I find good cause to amend Order No. 21-414. In the conclusion of Appendix A under the heading Proposed Commission Motion on page 8 Order No. 21-414 is amended to state: "2. Approve an annual interest rate of 0.1 percent on customer deposits for calendar year 2022."
