ORDER

DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED

On April 16, 2008, Sprint Communications Co., LP was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 08-221.

In a letter received December 8, 2021, Heather Moelter, Counsel to Sprint Communications Co., LP, requested the Commission cancel the company's certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as it has ceased offering competitive telecommunications services requiring certification in Oregon. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2021, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Sprint Communications Co., LP should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Sprint Communications Co., LP is canceled.
