ORDER

**DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED**

On July 16, 2009, Communication Telefonicas Latinas Corp. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See Order No. 09-277.*

In a letter dated March 21, 2022, Rodney Harrison, President of Communication Telefonicas Latinas Corp., requested the Commission cancel the company's certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as it is no longer providing services to Oregon customers. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2022, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Communication Telefonicas Latinas Corp. should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Communication Telefonicas Latinas Corp. is canceled.
