ORDER

DISPOSITION: EFFECTIVE DATE SPECIFIED IN ORDER NO. 22-085 AMENDED

On March 21, 2022, the Commission approved a joint stipulation for a modified general rate revision for Sunriver Water, LLC (Sunriver).

While Order No. 22 -085 correctly listed the effective date of the new tariffs as May 1, 2022 in the opening paragraph, it was incorrectly stated as “May 28, 2022” in ordering paragraph number 3.

The Chief Administrative Law Judge has been delegated the authority to modify timelines specified in a Commission order.¹ Exercising that authority, I find good cause to amend Order No. 22-085. Ordering paragraph number 3, which authorizes Sunriver to immediately file tariffs in accordance with the adopted stipulation, “with an effective date of May 28, 2022” is amended to state “with an effective date of May 1, 2022.”
