ORDER

DISPOSITION: SUSPENSION DATE SPECIFIED IN ORDER NO. 22-252 AMENDED

On July 8, 2022, Order No. 22-252 was entered suspending Advice No. 22-03, filed by Avion Water Company, Inc. While Order No. 22-252 correctly stated that Advice No. 22-03 was suspended for a period not to exceed six months from August 1, 2022, the following sentence states that the suspension would be in effect until May 1, 2023. This is incorrect, the suspension should expire on February 1, 2023.

The Chief Administrative Law Judge has been delegated the authority to modify timelines specified in a Commission order.¹ Exercising that authority, I find good cause to amend Order No. 22-252. The final sentence of the order is amended to state that “Advice No. 22-03 is suspended until February 1, 2023.”
