DISPOSITION: MOTION TO AMEND GENERAL PROTECTIVE ORDER  
NO. 16-270 GRANTED

On October 6, 2022 Portland General Electric filed in this docket a motion to amend General Protective Order No. 16-270, noting that this date must change because the reasons for the general protective order still exist, and will continue for a significant period of time. PGE represents that Staff, Oregon Citizens' Utility Board, and the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers do not oppose the motion. For good cause shown, I grant the motion. The first sentence of Paragraph 20 of Order No. 16-270 is amended as follows:

The Commission will preserve the designation of information as protected for a period of ~~five years from the date of the final order in these proceedings~~ not to exceed 12/31/2026, unless extended by the Commission at the request of the designating party.
