ERRATA ORDER

DISPOSITION: ORDER NO. 22-427 CORRECTED

On November 1, 2022, the Commission issued Order No. 22-427, adopting a comprehensive stipulation for all issues regarding Portland General Electric Company's 2023 Annual Power Cost Update Tariff. The second ordering paragraph states "Portland General Electric Company must file a final MONET run on or before November 7, 2022, producing the final Annual Update Tariff adjustment for 2022."

Consistent with PGE's tariff Schedule 125, and the procedural schedule issued in this docket on May 9, 2022, PGE's final MONET update is scheduled for November 15, 2022, not November 7, 2022.

The Chief Administrative Law Judge has been delegated the authority to modify timelines specified in a Commission order.<sup>1</sup> Exercising that authority, I find good cause to amend Order No. 22-427. The second ordering paragraph on page 8 is amended to state: "Portland General Electric Company must file a final MONET run on or before November 15, 2022, producing the final Annual Update Tariff adjustment for 2022."
