DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED

On June 6, 2004, Long Distance Consolidated Billing Co. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 04-309.

In a letter dated December 19, 2022, Patrick D. Crocker, Attorney for Long Distance Consolidated Billing Co., requested the Commission cancel the company's certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as it has no Oregon customers. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2022, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Long Distance Consolidated Billing Co. should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Long Distance Consolidated Billing Co. is canceled.
