DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED

On January 31, 2000, PriorityONE Telecommunications, Inc. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 00-044.

In a letter dated January 31, 2023, Kelly Mutch, President of PriorityONE Telecommunications, Inc., requested the Commission cancel the company's certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as it has been sold to Ziply Fiber. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2023, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by PriorityONE Telecommunications, Inc. should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by PriorityONE Telecommunications, Inc. is canceled.
