ORDER

**DISPOSITION: JOINT MOTION TO AMEND ORDER NO. 22-340 TO EXTEND
PRICE PLAN GRANTED**

On September 23, 2022, Order No. 22-340 was entered extending Lumen Technologies' (Lumen's) Price Plan from its original four-year term to four years and nine months. On March 27, 2023, all parties to this proceeding including Lumen, Staff, the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board, and Priscilla Weaver jointly moved to amend Order No 22-340 to extend the current price plan by an additional three months, through September 28, 2023, for the stated purpose of providing parties additional time to negotiate and reach agreement on terms for a new price plan.

The Chief Administrative Law Judge has been delegated the authority to modify timelines specified in a Commission order.² Exercising that authority, I find good cause to amend Order No. 22-340.

2. The remainder of Order No. 22-340 is unchanged.
