**DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED**

On June 16, 2006, Nationwide Long Distance Service, Inc. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 06-304.

In a letter dated April 21, 2023, Kenny Perkins, Consultant for Nationwide Long Distance Service, Inc., requested the Commission cancel the company's certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as it is no longer providing services to Oregon customers. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2023, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Nationwide Long Distance Service, Inc. should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Nationwide Long Distance Service, Inc. is canceled.
