ORDER

**DISPOSITION: PRICE PLAN IMPLEMENTATION FURTHER EXTENDED;
ORDER NO. 22-340 FURTHER AMENDED**

On September 19, 2023, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon held a prehearing conference in docket UM 1908 regarding the schedule for the remainder of these proceedings. At this prehearing conference, the parties proposed a schedule as well as a new expiration date of February 29, 2024, for Lumen Technologies' ¹ price plan, which is currently set to expire on September 28, 2023. ² On September 25, 2023, Administrative Law Judge Sarah Spruce issued a memorandum establishing the schedule, which would extend beyond the current price plan expiration date of September 28, 2023.

The Chief Administrative Law Judge has been delegated the authority to modify timelines specified in a Commission order. ³ Exercising that authority, I find good cause

to further amend Order No. 22-340 to extend the original term of Lumen's price plan through February 29, 2024.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The first numbered sentence of the Staff proposed Commission Motion on page 9 of Appendix A to Order No. 22-340 is modified to read "Modify Lumen's Price Plan to extend the original term of four years to February 29, 2024."
2. The remainder of Order No. 22-340 is unchanged.
