ORDER

DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED

On September 1, 2004, Telecom Management, Inc. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider in Docket CP 1244. *See* Order No. 04-500. Telecom Management, Inc. was granted authority for additional services on April 11, 2007, in Docket CP 1362. *See* Order No. 07-142.

In a letter dated October 20, 2023, Mark Lammert, Attorney-in-Fact for Telecom Management, Inc., requested the Commission cancel the company's certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as it is no longer providing services in Oregon.

The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2023, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Telecom Management, Inc. should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Telecom Management, Inc. is canceled.
