ORDER

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO WITHDRAW APPLICATION GRANTED; DOCKET CLOSED

On April 11, 2024, Tempo Telecom, LLC filed a motion to withdraw its July 27, 2023, application for designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier (ETC) and eligible telecommunications provider (ETP). Tempo explains it “has determined that the best course of action at this time is to withdraw its ETC Application and close this proceeding” and that no party opposes the motion. Tempo requests that its withdrawal be without prejudice to its right to file a new application in the future.

Order No. 23-321 delegates authority to the Chief Administrative Law Judge to issue orders closing a docket where, prior to an evidentiary hearing, the applicant voluntarily withdraws the pleading initiating the docket. After reviewing Tempo’s motion and based on its representations, I find that good cause exists to grant Tempo’s motion and close this docket.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Tempo’s motion to withdraw its application for designation as an ETC and ETP is granted without prejudice to file a new application in the future; and
2. This docket is closed.
