DISPOSITION: TIMELINE SPECIFIED IN ORDER NO. 24-091 AMENDED

Order No. 24-091 suspended the tariff date to August 1, 2024, for a period of two months from June 1, 2024, the effective date of the tariff sheets. Subsequently, the Chief Administrative Law Judge suspended the tariff sheets until October 1, 2024, in Order No. 24-134. I find good cause exists to further suspend the tariff until November 1, 2024.

The Chief Administrative Law Judge has been delegated the authority to modify timelines specified in a Commission order. The Administrative Law Judge assigned to this case has adopted a schedule that extends beyond October 1, 2024. Accordingly, I find good cause to further amend Order No. 24-091, paragraph 1 in the ordering paragraph to read:

Advice No. 23-20 filed by Portland General Electric Company is suspended for a period of five months from June 1, 2024, the effective date of the tariff sheets.

The remainder of the order remains unchanged.
