ORDER

DISPOSITION: EXPEDITED REQUEST FOR EXTENSION GRANTED;  
TIMELINE IN ORDER NO. 24-026 AMENDED

On July 29, 2024, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon filed a motion requesting a further extension of time to file a Community Solar Program (CSP) financial analysis. In Order No. 24-026 the Commission adopted the recommendation in the January 16, 2024 Staff Report that Staff would provide a CSP financial analysis by June 30, 2024.<sup>1</sup> In Order No. 24-226, that date was extended to July 31, 2024. Staff requests the due date for the CSP financial analysis be extended until September 16, 2024 to provide adequate time to finalize the CSP financial analysis to facilitate Commission decisions regarding future program design changes. Staff requests expedited consideration of its motion.

The Chief Administrative Law Judge has been delegated the authority to modify timelines specified in a Commission order.<sup>2</sup> Exercising that authority, I find good cause to amend the due date of the CSP financial analysis in Order No. 24-026, to September 16, 2024.
