In the Matter of SYNDEO LLC (ID #8820) Assessment of OUS Quarterly Payments

ORDER

DISPOSITION: \$186.99 CHARGES ASSESSED

In this order, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon assesses \$186.99 against SYNDEO LLC for failure to make required payments. The Commission designates its files on the subject of this matter as the record in this case and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

SYNDEO LLC is a telecommunications provider required to submit quarterly contribution worksheets and payments to the Commission for the Oregon Universal Service Fund (OUSF).¹ These amounts can include any or all of the following: contribution payment(s), late payment penalty(ies), interest and late statement fee(s), including any portion due but not paid for the period(s).²

SYNDEO LLC failed to meet these requirements by failing to pay the FIrst Quarter of 2024.³

The Commission sent a Proposed Order to SYNDEO LLC on 7/17/2024. SYNDEO LLC did not respond with full payment, and all current amounts owing have not been paid.

CONCLUSIONS

SYNDEO LLC failed to meet its filing obligations required by law. SYNDEO LLC owes the current balance of \$186.99. These charges are for the First Quarter of 2024.

The amount set forth above should be assessed, with the applicable interest to accrue at 9 percent per annum until the Commission receives full contribution payment.⁴ For a current payment amount, please contact Laurel Anderson at (971) 375-5059 (laurel.anderson@puc.oregon.gov).

Failure to comply with the terms of this order may result in the Commission suspending or cancelling the telecommunications provider's Certificate of Authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon.⁵

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. SYNDEO LLC is assessed \$186.99 immediately due and payable to the Public Utility Commission, PO Box 2153, Salem, Oregon 97308-2153.
- 2. Where applicable, interest will continue to accrue at 9 percent per annum until the Commission receives full contribution payment.
- 3. Under ORS 293.231, the Commission must refer your account to the Department of Revenue or a private collection firm if it receives no payment on the amount due and payable in this Order by the due date of 10/21/2024, which is ninety days from its 7/17/2024 origination date. Non payment will result in a minimum 20% collection fee added to the amount you owe.
