DISPOSITION: ORDER NO. 24-359 CORRECTED

On October 25, 2024, we entered Order No. 24-359, which adopted stipulations between the parties and resolved the remaining issues in this docket. Upon review, we find an error, in which two numbers were transposed, in the decision.

On page 16, the order refers to the "\$8 customer charge for single-family premises customers and the \$10 customer charge for multi-family premises customers* * *." These numbers were transposed, and the sentence should instead refer to the \$10 customer charge for single-family premises customers and the \$8 customer charge for multi-family premises customers. This error is hereby corrected.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the language in Order No. 24-359 on page 16 referring to the single-family and multi-family premises customer charges is corrected to read:

Consistent with the second partial stipulation adopted earlier in this order, we direct NW Natural to file updated tariff sheets including the \$10 customer charge for single-family premises customers and the \$8 customer charge for multi-family premises customers as settled by the second partial stipulation, as well as recalculating the residential rates.

The remainder of the order remains unchanged.
