ORDER

**DISPOSITION: AMENDED PROPOSED BUDGET FOR ISSUE FUND GRANT
APPROVED**

On December 17, 2024, the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board (CUB) filed a proposed budget for an Issue Fund Grant in this proceeding. CUB sought an Issue Fund Grant of \$45,000. The Commission approved that proposed budget in Order No. 24-465. On May 2, 2025, CUB filed an amended proposed budget. On May 29, 2025, CUB amended its Issue Fund request and amended budget, showing \$107,000 in eligible expenses and seeking an additional \$40,000 in funding from the 2025 Avista Issue Fund, bringing the total issue fund grant to \$85,000.

Section 6.7 of the Fifth Amended and Restated Intervenor Funding Agreement (IFA), approved by the Commission in Order No. 22-506, provides that an intervenor who received Commission approval for an Issue Fund Grant may file to amend its budget and request additional funding due to unforeseen changes in the scope or complexity of issues, positions taken by other parties, changes in the schedule of the case, or other good cause.

Once an amended proposed budget is received, the Commission decides whether additional Issue Fund Grants are available for use based on factors identified in the IFA. The Commission has the authority to accept, deny, or partially deny the request, and may place reasonable conditions on the grant.

CUB was automatically precertified to receive Issue Fund Grants under Section 5.2(a) of the IFA and OAR 860-001-0120(3)(a). CUB's amended proposed budget includes the requisite information and reflects the schedule adopted in this docket.

In light of the issues being addressed, the complexity of the issues and the significant policy decisions implicated, the Commission believes that CUB's amended proposed budget is reasonable and should be approved.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Oregon Citizens' Utility Board's proposed budget for an Issue Fund Grant is approved.
2. An Issue Fund Grant is approved up to \$85,000.
