Transportation Electrification Plan.

DISPOSITION: TIMELINE SPECIFIED IN ORDER NO. 25-146 AMENDED

In Order No. 25-146, the Commission waived the May 1, 2025 deadline for Portland General Electric Company to file its 2026-2028 Transportation Electrification Plan (TE Plan) and established a deadline of July 1, 2025. PGE requests a modification of this timeline to allow the company to file its draft 2026-2028 TE Plan no later than July 25, 2025. PGE states that the company is waiting for critical third-party information that will affect various aspects of its own fleet electrification plan and that submission of the TE Plan without this information would provide insufficient information to review the company's strategy. No party filed an objection to PGE's request.

The Chief Administrative Law Judge has been delegated the authority to modify timelines specified in a Commission order. I find good cause to amend Order No. 25-146, to require the Company to file its 2026-2028 TE Plan no later than July 25, 2025.

The remainder of the order remains unchanged.
