ORDER

DISPOSITION: INTERIM RELIEF EXTENDED

On July 8, 2025, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon entered an order granting on a temporary basis Green Solar LLC's request for interim relief against PacifiCorp on the condition that Green Solar filed an amended complaint by July 11, 2025. We granted Green Solar's motion for interim relief for a period of 30 days or until such time as the Commission could issue an order on the initial motion, whichever occurred first.¹ On July 11, 2025, Green Solar filed an amended complaint. On August 6, 2025, PacifiCorp filed a supplemental response to Green Solar's motion requesting an opportunity for additional briefing and agreeing not to exercise contractual breach remedies until the conclusion of the prehearing conference, scheduled for July 21, 2025. On August 18, 2025, Green Solar filed a reply to PacifiCorp requesting that the Commission immediately rule on its motion for interim relief or in the alternative prohibit PacifiCorp from terminating the interconnection agreement until the Commission rules on the request for interim relief.

Administrative Law Judge Sarah Spruce will hold a prehearing conference to discuss the procedural schedule and PacifiCorp's request for additional briefing.

To permit the parties sufficient time to address procedural matters and for the Commission to consider Green Solar's motion, we extend the temporary interim relief

granted in Order No. 25-254 until such time as the Commission issues an order on the merits of the motion for interim relief.

I. ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Green Solar LLC's request for interim relief against PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power, is granted on a temporary basis pending a decision on the merits.
