Request for Re-authorization to Defer Industrial DSM Program Costs.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that Northwest Natural's (NW Natural, NWN, or Company) application for reauthorization to defer, with interest, the incremental costs associated with the Industrial Demand Side Management (DSM) program be approved for the 12-month period beginning March 1, 2025.

DISCUSSION:

Issue

Whether the Commission should approve NW Natural's request for reauthorization to defer the incremental costs associated with the Company's Industrial DSM program for later recovery in rates.

Applicable Law

NW Natural submitted its deferral application on February 28, 2025, in accordance with ORS 757.259(2)(e), ORS 757.262, and OAR 860-027-0300. The statute ORS 757.259(2)(e) provides the Commission with authority to authorize the deferral of utility revenues and expenses, for later inclusion in rates, upon finding that the deferral would minimize the frequency of rate changes or the fluctuation of rate levels or to match appropriately the costs borne by and benefits received by ratepayers.

OAR 860-027-0300 is the Commission's rule governing the use of deferred accounting by energy and large telecommunications utilities. Previous approval of this deferral was most recently granted by Order No. 21-116.

ORS 757.262 addresses the Commission's authority regarding utility acquisition of costeffective conservation resources and small-scale, renewable-fuel electric generating resources.

Analysis

Background

NW Natural seeks to defer all costs associated with studying, planning, administering, and delivering Demand Side Management ("DSM") programs to Industrial Firm Sales Customers, Industrial Interruptible Sales Customers, and Schedule 32, Commercial Sales Customers (referred to hereafter collectively as "Industrial Customers").

The Company has offered DSM programs to its Residential and Commercial Customers since 2002. In 2009, the Company began offering its Industrial Customers a program, established in response to NW Natural's 2008 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP). In the IRP, the Company identified cost-effective DSM for its Industrial Firm Sales Customers.

Although the Company's 2008 IRP did not include a DSM technical potential study for Industrial Interruptible Sales Customers, the program offering was extended to these industrial customers in accordance with the program parameters established in a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), signed by NW Natural, Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon, CUB, Northwest Industrial Gas Users, NWIGU, and Commission Staff.

The MOU stated the Company would provide an energy-efficiency program to Industrial Customers for two years, after which time the MOU signatories would consider whether the program should continue being offered to interruptible sales customers.

In 2011, the MOU signatories agreed that the pilot Industrial DSM Program should become a permanent offering. The program that is offered today continues to be applicable to all industrial customers except those receiving service under a transportation rate.

Description of Expenses

The Company is requesting to defer the costs associated with studying, planning, administering, and delivering its Industrial DSM Program.

Proposed Accounting

The Company proposes to account for the deferred expenses related to the Industrial DSM Program by recording the deferral in a sub-account of Account 186 (Miscellaneous Deferred Debits).

Reasons for Deferral

The deferral mechanism is used consistent with the original MOU discussed above.

Estimate of Amounts

The Company estimates the amount to be recorded in the deferred account for the 12-month period beginning March 1, 2025, through February 28, 2026, to be approximately \$11,247,910.

Information Related to Future Amortization

- Earnings review An earnings review must be conducted for amortization of these costs.
- Prudence Review A prudence review is required prior to amortization and should include the verification of the accounting methodology used to determine the final amortization balance. The prudence review will be held when NW Natural files for amortization.
- Sharing Staff has not previously recommended sharing for this deferral.
- Rate Spread/Design The costs are allocated among Industrial Firm Sales
 Customers, Industrial Interruptible Sales Customers, and Schedule 32
 Commercial Sales Customers on an equal cents per therm basis.

Conclusion

As Schedule 360, Industrial Demand Side Management Programs, is still in effect, and this application meets the statutory requirements of ORS 757.259 and OAR 860-027-0300, I recommend Commission approval.
