ORDER

**DISPOSITION: PETITION WITHDRAWN; DOCKET CLOSED**

On July 18, 2025, PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power, filed a petition for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) authorizing construction of the Malin to Bonanza transmission line project. On September 30, 2025, PacifiCorp filed a motion requesting to withdraw its petition, explaining that there was no longer a need for a CPCN.

Order No. 23-321 delegates authority to the Chief Administrative Law Judge to issue orders closing a docket where, prior to an evidentiary hearing, the applicant or petitioner voluntarily withdraws the pleading initiating the docket.<sup>1</sup> After reviewing PacifiCorp's request, I find good cause to close this docket. PacifiCorp's petition is withdrawn, and this docket is closed.

**ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that docket PCN 7 is closed.
