ORDER

DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED

On 9/24/2024, Prime Fiber LLC was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 24-327.

In a letter dated 12/16/2025, Mark Lammert, Attorney-in-Fact, for Prime Fiber LLC, requested the Commission cancel the company's certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as it never became operational in Oregon and has no Oregon customers. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2025, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Prime Fiber LLC should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Prime Fiber LLC is canceled.
