ORDER

**DISPOSITION: TARIFF SHEETS SUSPENDED**


On January 22, 2026, Portland General Electric Company filed revised tariff sheets in Advice No. 25-31 to be effective February 23, 2026.<sup>1</sup> The filing seeks an increase in customer rates. We find good and sufficient cause exists to investigate the propriety and reasonableness of the tariff sheets under ORS 757.210 and 757.215.

ORS 757.215(1) authorizes the suspension of a rate filing for a period up to ten months. We conclude at this time that a five-month suspension is necessary to investigate these rate proceedings, consistent with the procedural schedule, which provides for a July 1, 2026 rate effective date.

**ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that Advice No. 25-31 filed by Portland General Electric Company is suspended for a period of time of up to five months from February 23, 2026, the effective date of the tariff sheets.
