ORDER

**DISPOSITION: TIMELINE SPECIFIED IN ORDER NO. 25-127 AMENDED**

On March 30, 2026, Portland General Electric Company filed a motion requesting to modify the deadline for the company’s 2026 integrated resource plan (IRP) and clean energy plan (CEP) to September 30, 2026. Under Order No. 25-127, PGE’s 2026 IRP and CEP is due June 18, 2026. The company asserts that there is good cause for the three-month extension to allow time to review and analyze data and engage with stakeholders to address the recently adopted rules in docket AR 669 and conduct additional stakeholder engagement. The company represents that the extension is not expected to have downstream impacts on dockets that depend on data from the IRP/CEP and that 2025 request for proposals procurement efforts will continue during this timeframe. No party filed a response to the company’s motion.

The Chief Administrative Law Judge has been delegated the authority to modify timelines specified in a Commission order.<sup>1</sup> I find good cause to amend Order No. 25-127, to modify the deadline for the company’s 2026 IRP and CEP to September 30, 2026.

Order No. 25-127 is amended to change the deadline from “June 18, 2026” to “September 30, 2026.” The remainder of the order remains unchanged.
