ORDER

DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED

On December 2, 2004, Accessline Communications Corporation was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 04-701.

In a letter dated April 30, 2026, Glenn Richards, Counsel for Accessline Communications Corporation, requested the Commission cancel the company's certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as it is no longer providing services to Oregon customers. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2026, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Accessline Communications Corporation should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Accessline Communications Corporation is canceled.
