ORDER

**DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED**

On April 14, 2009, Broadvox-CLEC LLC was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 09-130.

In a letter dated May 8, 2026, Carey Rose, Consultant for Broadvox-CLEC LLC, requested the Commission cancel the company's certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as it is no longer providing services to Oregon customers. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2026, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Broadvox-CLEC LLC should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Broadvox-CLEC LLC is canceled.
