ORDER

DISPOSITION: CASE FUND GRANT REQUEST PAYMENT ORDERED

On June 2, 2026, the Community Energy Project (CEP) filed a request for final payment of its Case Fund Grant in this docket. CEP asks for a final payment of \$625.00 from the 2026 Portland General Electric Justice Funding Case Fund. CEP's proposed budget was approved in Order No. 26-066 on March 4, 2026. No party responded to CEP's request for payment.

The Commission has delegated responsibility to sign uncontested orders relating to Intervenor Funding Agreements, including authorizing partial or final payments, to the Chief Administrative Law Judge, consistent with Order No. 25-408.¹

The Environmental Justice Communities Funding Agreement (approved by the Commission in Order No. 25-409)² governs the procedures for payment of Case Fund Grants. CEP is pre-certified as an Eligible Recipient under the Agreement.

Under the Agreement, a Request for Payment must:

- a) Itemize the expenses, payees and hourly rates for amounts to be reimbursed, including billing details, and including separately identified amounts for consultant or expert witness fees and travel expenses;

- b) Demonstrate that the expenses are reasonable and are directly attributable to issues and positions pursued on behalf of low-income residential customers or Environmental Justice Communities and consistent with the Grant Recipient's Proposed Budget;
- c) Provide information sufficient to show that the Grant Recipient has complied with any condition or requirement of the Case Fund Grant; and
- d) Specify whether the request for payment is for a progress payment of final payment in full and indicate whether any approved budget amount may be released back to the applicable Case Fund because the Grant Recipient does not intend to request payment for the full approved budget amount.

CEP has provided the required documentation in its request for final payment.

The Commission finds that CEP has met the requirements of the Agreement and its request for final payment should be approved. Section 7.6 of the Agreement provides that the utility must pay the Case Fund Grant to the Eligible Entity within 30 days of receiving notice of a directive from the Commission.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Community Energy Project has met the requirements of the Environmental Justice Communities Justice Funding Agreement and its request is approved.
- 2. Portland General Electric Company pay \$625.00 from its 2026 Case Fund to Community Energy Project within 30 days after receipt of this Order.
