DISPOSITION: STIPULATION ADOPTED

On September 23, 1999, a complaint was filed by the Public Utility Commission of Oregon against defendant. The complaint charged defendant with five violations of law and requested a penalty of \$2,500. On September 24, 1999, a copy of the complaint was served.

On October 15, 1999, the parties to this proceeding entered into a stipulation which is attached.

The defendant admits committing the violations alleged in the complaint. The stipulation is approved.

From the foregoing, it is concluded that no hearing is required; that, under the terms of the stipulation, the allegations of the complaint are true; that defendant has violated Oregon Administrative Rule(s) as alleged; and that, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 757.993, penalties should be assessed against defendant under the terms and conditions of the stipulation.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Civil monetary penalties shall be assessed against defendant in the amount of \$1,000; and
- 2. Defendant shall pay the sum of \$250, due and payable within 30 days from the date of service of this order; and
- 3. Payment of the balance of the penalties (\$750) shall be suspended for a period of one year following entry of this order; and
- 4. One violation of OAR 952-001-0050(1) and two violations of OAR 952-001-0090 are dismissed.

3	monetary penalties against the defendant in the amount of \$1000 under the following terms and
4	conditions:
5	A. With respect to the violations of OAR 952-001-0050(1), \$250 shall become due and payable
6	on or before the thirteenth day following the Commission's entry of a final order in this case.
7	Payment of the balance of the penalties (\$750) shall be suspended for a period of one year
8	following the entry of the Commission's final order in this case. If defendant complies with
9	all of the rules adopted by the Oregon Utility Notification Center (OUNC) under ORS
10	757.552 for that one year period, the balance of the penalties (\$750) shall be dismissed and
11	no further penalties shall be imposed for the violations alleged in the Complaint. One
12	violation of OAR 952-001-0050(1) is dismissed.
13	B. The violations of OAR 952-001-0090 are dismissed.
14	C. In the event that complainant contends that the defendant has not complied with all OUNC
15	rules for that one year period, complainant may reopen this proceeding and petition for

18	compliance has not occurred.
