ORDER

**DISPOSITION: JOINT MOTION GRANTED**

On October 20, 1999, AirTouch Paging (AirTouch) and U S WEST Communications, Inc. (USWC) filed a joint motion with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon requesting an order:

1. Allowing USWC to withdraw, with prejudice, its Petition for Arbitration of an Interconnection Agreement with AirTouch filed on August 25, 1999;
2. Allowing AirTouch to withdraw, with prejudice, its Motion to Dismiss the Arbitration Petition of USWC filed on September 20, 1999;
3. Allowing USWC to withdraw, with prejudice, its Opposition to AirTouch's Motion to Dismiss the Arbitration Petition of USWC filed on September 20, 1999; and
4. Allowing AirTouch to withdraw, with prejudice, its Response to USWC's Petition for Arbitration of an Interconnection Agreement filed on September 20, 1999.

In support of the joint motion, AirTouch and USWC state that the parties have entered into a voluntarily negotiated Paging Interconnection Agreement, dated October 18, 1999, which will be submitted to the Commission shortly. The Commission finds that good reason exists to grant the joint motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the joint motion filed by AirTouch and USWC on October 20, 1999 is granted.
