DISPOSITION: ORDER NO. 99-408 AMENDED

On March 11, 1999, the Central Lincoln People's Utility District (CLPUD) filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) for an allocation of exclusively served territory pursuant to ORS 758.435 and OAR 860-025-0020. CLPUD filed a motion to amend its application on May 24, 1999.

On June 22, 1999, Commission Staff and CLPUD entered into a Stipulation for Approval of CLPUD's Application for an Allocation of Exclusively Served Territory. In the Stipulation, the parties identified the documents to be included in the administrative record for Docket UA 68 and agreed that the Motion to Amend should be granted and the application, as amended, should be approved. In Order No. 99-408 the Commission approved the Stipulation.

Subsequently, in the process of digitizing maps of Oregon electric utility distribution areas, Staff discovered an irregularity relating to a small portion of a boundary line. Staff notified CLPUD of the error. On November 3, 1999, CLPUD filed a request to amend Order No. 99-408 to correct the geographic overlap.

Commission Staff reviewed the revised maps and metes and bounds description filed by CLPUD on November 3, 1999, and finds that they correct the geographic overlap created in Order No. 99-408. The revised metes and bounds description is attached to this order as Exhibit B, to replace the Exhibit B attached to Order No. 99-408.

## **ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 99-408 is amended by replacing Exhibit B with the corrected metes and bounds description attached to this order.
