## DISPOSITION: TARIFF SHEETS SUSPENDED FOR AN ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF TIME

On October 25, 1999, U S WEST Communications, Inc., filed tariff sheets in Advice No. 1808 to be effective December 1, 1999. The terms of the proposed tariff sheets were set forth in a Staff Report dated November 18, 1999.

At its November 30, 1999, public meeting, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon found good and sufficient cause exists to investigate the propriety and reasonableness of the rates pursuant to ORS 759.180 and 759.185. The Commission ordered suspension of the advice pending that investigation.

On November 30, 1999, Order No. 99-733 was entered suspending Advice No. 1808 for a six-month period of time.

The Commission will not have an opportunity to complete its investigation in this case prior to the expiration of the initial suspension period. Accordingly, the suspension should be extended for an additional period not exceeding three months pursuant to ORS 757.185(1).
