DISPOSITION: AGREEMENT ADOPTED

At its June 20, 2000, public meeting, the Commission adopted an agreement between the Commission Staff and U S WEST Communications, Inc. (USWC). The agreement would suspend filing requirements for affiliated interest contracts and related reports.

Staff recommended that the Commission adopt its agreement with USWC because the passage of Senate Bill 622 and USWC's election to be regulated under an alternative form of regulation obviate the need for the filings and reports. The only instance where a filing might be required is when the affiliate relationship impacts rates for basic service. Under the agreement, USWC agrees to:

- 1. By June 30 of each year, file an annual report identifying each affiliate with whom they have transacted business, as well as the amount paid to and received from each affiliate for the reporting period.
- 2. Maintain its books and records pertaining to affiliated interest contracts in manner that will allow Staff to readily identify all costs associated with these contracts.
- 3. Upon request from Staff, file affiliated interest contracts when the contract impacts a proceeding concerning USWC's basic telephone rates.

Staff's public meeting memorandum recommending approval of the agreement and a copy of the agreement itself is attached as Appendix A.

ORDER NO.00-382

We have considered the recommendation and conclude that it is reasonable.

IT IS ORDERED that the agreement between the Commission Staff and US WEST Communications, Inc., is adopted.
