DISPOSITION: CLARIFICATION ORDER MODIFYING PREAPPLICATION PROCEDURES ADOPTED

On May 5, 2000, we issued Order No. 00-243 in this docket, adopting a series of procedures reflecting the unique nature of this proceeding. Among the procedures set forth in Appendix A to our order was the following:

2. Administration of Proceedings. The conduct of the workshops and preparation of Workshop Findings and Recommendation Reports shall be by a committee (Committee). The Committee shall be chaired by an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) designated to preside over the proceedings and shall include members of the Commission staff (Staff) designated by the ALJ. The rules regarding *ex parte* communications shall, in this docket, apply to the Commissioners, ALJ and members of the Staff designated as members of the Committee described above.

In our order, the Committee, identified in paragraph 2. above, was given particular duties with respect to the presentation of information to the Commission and the overall conduct of these proceedings. Upon further review, the Commission is of the opinion that the efficient administration of this docket necessitates that our authority be delegated solely to the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) designated by the Commission to preside in this matter. In so doing, we vest in the ALJ all of the authority and responsibilities assigned to the Committee in the Appendix to Order No. 00-243 and authorize the ALJ to designate those persons, in addition to ourselves, who shall be governed by the *ex parte* rules.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Commission's Order No. 00-243, adopted May 5, 2000, and Appendix A, thereto, are hereby MODIFIED to the extent noted above.
